- The State of Oregon requires proof of high school graduation, equivalent or above for initial Specialist or Tester certifications. Initial Specialist certification also requires at least one year of water system or plumbing experience.
- Class tuitions are not refundable. Tuitions are transferable, but only when BMI is notified of the inability to attend no later than 3 business days before the start of the class. BMI must be given adequate time to fill a vacated seat or any tuition fees paid will be forfeited. BMI reserves the right to cancel/reschedule any class due to low enrollment, inclement weather or for any other reason. In this case, the normal tuition policy will still apply.
